"This We'll Defend" The U.S. Army Celebrates 250 Years

On June 14, 1775, two months after the "shot heard round the world" at Lexington and Concord, Massachusetts, Congress established a "continental" fighting force representing all 13 colonies for the Revolutionary War. The Continental Army thus became a national institution before the nation was even fully formed. One day later, Congress unanimously voted for George Washington to be the commander-in-chief of the Continental Army. Washington took command of his fledgling army on July 3, 1775, and led it through eight years of war with Great Britain that ended with the treaty of peace in September 1783. Five years later, the newly signed U.S. Constitution authorized a small permanent peacetime army under civilian control.

The 190 campaign streamers on the U.S. Army's flag symbolize our long-standing motto "This We'll Defend." During the 19th century, the U.S. Army explored and surveyed new territories, built roads and military defenses, protected settlers, and helped preserve the union during the Civil War. As the nation began to look outside its borders, the Army helped make the United States a world power by 1917. It created huge citizen armies and transported them across the globe to help bring two world wars to an end and committed troops around the world, including the battlefields of Korea and Vietnam, to ward off communist aggression.

In the 1970s, the U.S. Army transformed itself into a smaller, all-volunteer professional force. It deployed to dozens of contingencies around the world, from a war in Southwest Asia to check a dictator's power to smaller, diverse operations like humanitarian assistance, nation building, occupation, reconstruction, counterdrug operations, and peacekeeping. With the onset of the 20th century and the 9/11 terrorist attacks on American soil, the Army, like the nation it serves, has been committed to stamping out terrorism throughout the world, while fulfilling its essential homeland security responsibilities and preparing for potential large scale combat operations against its adversaries. As it has for 250 years, the U.S. Army continues to evolve to ensure it is prepared to defend the nation, its people, and its interests at home and around the world.

Since its establishment in 1877, Fort Huachuca has evolved to support the Army's requirements. It has protected settlers, trained Soldiers for combat, developed and tested state-of-the art electronic, communications, and aerial equipment, and shaped, trained, and fielded a Military Intelligence Corps that is "Always Out Front." A national treasure for nearly 150 years, Fort Huachuca remains a strategically important installation supporting the U.S. Army's motto: "This We'll Defend."

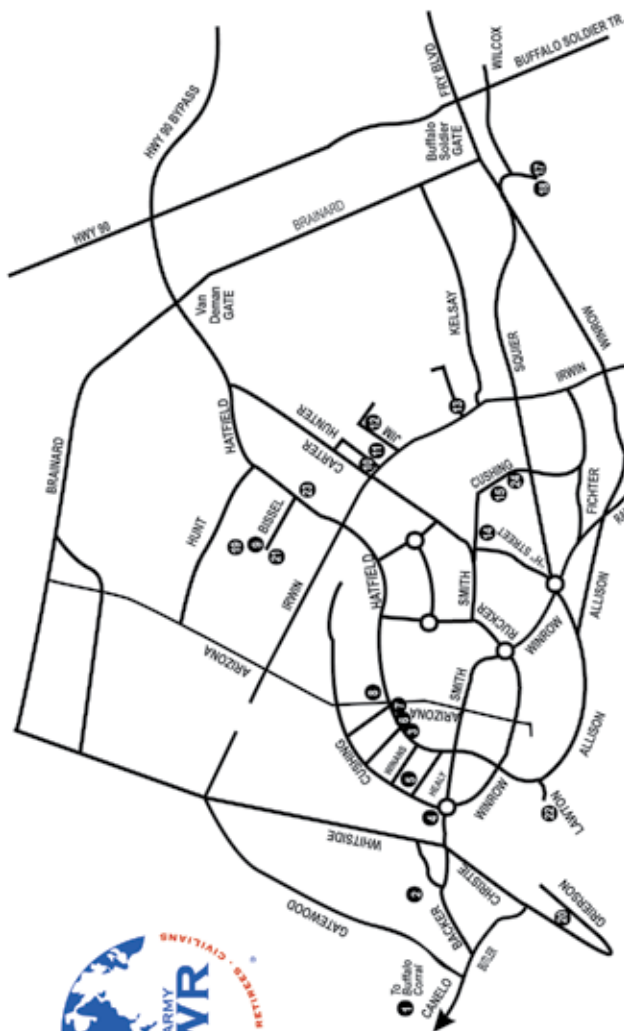
