

FORT HUACHUCA CHALLENGE COURSE NOW AVAILABLE

There's something new at Fort Huachuca: Outdoor Recreation recently announced that The Challenge Course is now available for reservations.

A challenge course is a combination of mental and physical challenges, requiring groups to work as a team to accomplish goals. Through a series of fun and unusual activities, participants learn valuable information about themselves, each other and the group as a unit.

By removing people from their usual environment, and placing them in a new, unique setting, a challenge course experience fosters shared learning, openness and cooperation.

The course was designed with groups of Soldiers in mind, such as those participating in the Warrior Adventure Quest. But the Challenge Course is also open to any other groups across the community, including Sierra Vista, that want to experience high adventure team building.

The course was not designed for competition nor is successful completion dependent upon speed.

In fact, the experience is completely customized to meet each group's goals and abilities—no two events are the same.

Group size can range from 8 to 50 participants. There is no age limitation for the Course—only size limitation. Participants must be large enough to fit safely into a harness, meaning the harness can be tightened around the waist, snugly like a belt. The maximum size to participate is 300 pounds, or if the participant cannot fit safely into a harness.

Although some risk is inevitable when completing a task like the Challenge Course, Outdoor Recreation has hired and uses a highly-trained staff, to make the course as safe as humanly possible.

The Challenge Course is available by **RESERVATION ONLY**. Reservations must be made at least 7 days prior to the event date, to allow for scheduling of adequate staff. A deposit of 50% of the total price is due at the time of reservation. Cancellations made 7 days or more prior to the event are eligible for a full refund. Cancellations within 7 days of the event will forfeit deposit amount.


