Additionally, please keep in mind the potential for attracting our desert critters as well as bees and wasps when looking at plants.

#### Our Wish list:

- A small pergola with a bench underneath
- Concrete benches and a small concrete table
- A child-safe water fountain (run during months that wasps are not abundant)
- Rock or concrete paths (keeping in mind handicapped access)
- Plants/flowers that children can easily wate r and maintain.




# NBCDC - Garden Project Right Side - Zen Garden
